# CONCUSSION MANDATE TRAINING



## INTRODUCTION

At the 2020 BCSS AGM, the membership unanimously passed a policy to mandate concussion training for all coaches, teacher sponsors, trainers, and team managers. This training is to be completed prior to any activities (ie practices, tryouts, workouts, etc) with student-athletes taking place.

It is the responsibility of the Athletic Director and School Administrator to ensure that all required personnel have completed the training. You are NOT required to submit the completions certification to BCSS however we recommend the AD require it from team personnel as BCSS may ask for proof of certification at any point. Certifications MUST be done through CATT and are valid for 2 years before needing re-certification.

# HOW TO COMPLETE THE TRAINING

To complete the hour long Concussion Awareness Training Tool (CATT) follow the steps below;

1) Go to www.cattonline.com/coach-course/ you will have the choice between the English or French version of the training. While the page estimates 45 minutes, most are able to complete in 30-40 minutes.

### Coach Course

The Concussion Awareness Training Tool (CATT) is a program designed to provide coaches with the information they need to provide evidence-based care for their athletes who have sustained a les renseignements dont ils ont besoin pour prodiguer des soins concussion.

At the end of the course, you will be prompted to enter your information to receive a certificate of completion. 
2) You will be directed to a page with a course overview of the 5 modules (A-E) and the final assessment, once you have reviewed the content start the course by clicking "Start Course"


The Concussion Awareness Training Tool (CATT) is a program designed to provide coaches with the information they need to provide evidence-based care for their athletes who have sustained a concussion.

- 3) You will be directed through the training step by step with videos, helpful documents, and interactive activities to test your knowledge throughout the course.
- 4) Once you have completed the training you are required to complete a Final Assessment before certification, you will need to <u>attain a score of 100%</u> to complete the certification



5) Once you have satisfactorily completed the final assessment you will be brought to the Certification page. There you will have to click the blue "certification form" button to fill out your information. It will open in another tab beside your certification page.





6) Once you are brought to the Certification Form you will need to fill out you're the following information; first name, last name, email, country, province, city, organization (BC School Sports), and sub organization (your school name).
